### **AMG International**

#### **Busia District Local Government**

Carried out a primary schools life skills outreach programme for Busia district to combat risky behavior amongst children who have been affected by the border environment of smuggling and the trailer drivers who practice commercial sex. This was a joint partnership with the district local government programme. A total of 5 schools were visited and slightly over 2500 children were trained.

#### **Iganga District Local Government**

Trained 210 youth leaders of Iganga in peer education and life skills approach to life. This was hosted at Nkuutu Memorial College.

#### **Wakiso District Local Government**

Trained 160 youth workers of Kasangati – Wakiso District in leadership and psychosocial skills.
